Sub. : - Adverse situation prevailing in different circles – regarding.

Sir,

I am constrained to bring to your kind notice that adverse situation is prevailing in different circle due to non-payment of wage to the contract workers of BSNL. I am narrating some of them for your kind appraisal.

In Kerala circle total work suspended and the contract workers went on agitation, since their wage is due for more than 4 months and the same time retrenchment of these workers took place. In CTD circle the contract workers went on agitation programme for the last three days for their wage which is due for two months. Similar programme was held yesterday, the 13th December, 2018 before the CGMT, West Bengal Circle where the wage of the contract workers is due for 2 months. The worst situation is prevailing at Up & Bihar, where the wage of the contract workers is due for more than 8 months. Similar situation is prevailing at Karnataka, Andhra etc.

Sir, you will surely agree with me that these contract labourers have kept the BSNL service alive in almost all the circles due to acute shortage of regular employees since superannuation. They are maintaining the BTS, battery, running the AC plants, generators etc. and also running the customer service centers. But it is unfortunate that these poor workers are not being paid their wage in due time. This has created lots of problems. In one hand GMs and CGMs are retrenching these workers on the other hand the field level officers are very much reluctant to make these labourers work. Since these officers are not in a position to pay their wages. As a result the BSNL service and day to day maintenance work is being hampered or going to be interrupted in various circles.

Under this situation I on behalf of this Federation seek your personal intervention to overcome this adverse situation by making arrangements to pay the wage of the poor contract workers working in BSNL.

Hope you will surely do the needful at your earliest.
