Sub: - Retrenchment order of the contract workers under the jurisdiction of PGM (Hyderabad) working in Andhra Pradesh and Telengana circles – req.

Please recall our discussion on 11th September, 2018, in your chamber on the above mentioned subject. It was reported to us that the PGM (Mtce.) STR circle has issued the order for retrenchment to some contract workers w.e.f. 15th September, 2018, under the jurisdiction of PGM(STR). Earlier, the matter was discussed with CGMT, STR. The circle Union leaders had requested for postponement of the proposed retrenchment of contract workers. The matter was again discussed with PGM (Mtce.), Hyderabad, on 23.06.2018 and we had requested not to issue any removal notice to the poor workers. The Management was very stiff to retrench at least 15% contract workers as per the Corporate Office order. Then, the local unions approached the Assistant Labour Commissioner and a conciliation meeting was held on 05th July, 2018. The recognize union (BSNLEU), local branch had also made a request to GM (HQ), Chennai to discuss the matter with the union for an amicable settlement. But it is unfortunate, that the management had issued the order again on 3rd July, to serve the notice for retrenchment to the contract workers under the jurisdiction of PGM (Mtce.) Hyderabad in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana circle.

On the above circumstance, I would like to request you that the poor workers had served the department since long and are getting the wages to serve their family members. They are very much active and sincere to the job particularly in the line maintenance, cable maintenance and the route maintenance also. Again, I request you to send a message to the local administration to discuss the matter with the union representatives for an amicable settlement.
